I participated in a class for 5th grade students using an ecogram (an analysis of a person's personality into five areas of the mind and a graph of one's strengths and weaknesses) to make it easy for anyone to take a personality test and find their own strengths and weaknesses. As a result of answering some questions, I was able to discover my strengths and weaknesses. In addition, by reflecting on myself, I was able to create an opportunity to think about how to actively be aware of behavior patterns and ways of thinking, and how to think and act. I think it is very important for children to correct their own habits and the parts they want to change in order to build relationships in the future. And I wanted them to value their own individuality and develop their good points.



PTA "Child Watch Team" School District Patrol



From 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, May 8 and Tuesday, June 4, members of the Iwata School District Voluntary Crime Prevention Blue Patrol Team, teachers, PTA officers, and committee members visited the school district to ensure the safety of the children. We rode in a car with a blue patrol light and patrolled on five routes (Kita-Iwata, Hirakawa-Honmachi, Naka-Iwata, Higashi-Iwata, and Iwata Sports Park). Along the way, we stopped at convenience stores and pharmacies and exchanged information while asking the people at the shops how they were doing. At each park, we looked around to see if the playground equipment was damaged, whether it could be used safely, whether there were trees or bushes that deteriorated visibility, whether there were any perverts, and whether there were any perverts, while imagining things related to the safety of children. On the way, if the child is playing alone and is playing in a worrying way, call out. By the way, it is said that the Blue Patrol Squad patrols about 100 days a year. Also, this time I was patrolling with the teachers, so I realized that there were many children who looked at us and greeted us properly, and that the greeting exercise was also thorough. What I thought after participating in the watch team this time was that even in an era where it is difficult to talk to children other than one's own children due to the weakening of connections between people, I am very grateful for the presence of the Mr./Ms. of the Blue Patrol Squad who are responding quickly for the safety of the school district. I realized once again that I need to be involved in activities to make the environment a better place to live.
