Notice regarding changes to additional fee for first-time patients (*Sentei Ryouyou-hi*) when examined at medical facilities

Thank you for your cooperation with and support for our school's activities.

Medical facilities above a certain size, such as hospitals, charge a fee for first-time patients. For Narita Memorial Hospital, these fees (*Sentei Ryouyou-hi*) will change from October 1, 2023.

In the event of an emergency under the supervision of school staff, children will be transferred to a hospital immediately, but the first-time patient fee(s) below must be paid by the child's guardian. Note that you can make an application to the city to subsidize any first-time patient fees paid on or after April 1, 2023.

1 First diagnosis medical fee

Toyohashi Municipal Hospital ( <i>Shimin Byouin</i> )	Elementary, Jr. High, High School	¥7,700
Toyohashi Medical Center ( <i>Iryou Center</i> )	Elementary and Jr. High	Free (¥1,650 after hours)
	High School	¥3,300
Narita Memorial Hospital ( <i>Kinen Byouin</i> )	Elementary, Jr. High, and High School	Medical : ¥7,700 Dentistry: ¥5,500

※the fees are not covered by insurance, so they are also not covered by Kodomo Iryou-hi or Sport Council benefits

2 Examples of times when fees will not be charged:

- You have a letter of referral from your doctor
- You are receiving support for medical payments (e.g. social welfare payments, medical treatment for single-parent households, etc.) (excludes standard beneficiary certificate/*Jukyusha-sho*)
- You were hospitalized after receiving treatment
- You bring results from an exam to a second exam
  - \* Note that these exceptions may differ depending on the facility
  - \* There is no additional fee for a first-time patient at Narita Memorial Hospital if transported there via ambulance.
